We will have a concession stand and will be selling chances for a beautiful cardinal quilt donated by Netta Silvey (Class of 1970). The quilt is on display at the Hale Bank until Homecoming. Chances are \$1/each or 6 for \$5. We will also be selling t-shirts, window clings, cookbooks, and much, MUCH more. Admission to the ballgame is a free-will donation.
